




## TOTAL NUMBERS OF PATIENTS TREATED




## HOSPITAL BASED/WALK IN PATIENTS VISIT




## COMUNITY OUTREACH PATIENTS VISIT






## TOTAL NUMBERS OF OTHER SURGERIES



## TOTAL NUMBERS OF REFRACTIVE ERRORS




